# hcopla



You can use Hoopla to stream movies, TV, music, and audiobooks or to read ebooks (including comics!) through the Portland Public Library. You just need your library card!

## Step 1: Sign up

To enjoy Hoopla content on your **phone** or **tablet** (iOS, Android, Kindle Fire HDX) download Hoopla for free from your app store.

If you are using a **computer** to access Hoopla, instead go to hoopladigital.com and follow these same steps.

The first time you use Hoopla, you will be prompted to sign up. Search for Portland Public Library and then select it. Enter your email address, a new password, and your PPL card number. Then Sign Up!

## Step 2: Look around

If you have a title in mind, simply search for it to see if it's available in Hoopla's library. If not, browsing is easy, with separate pages for different formats, dozens of genres to choose from, plus recommended and popular titles. **Can't find something?** You can always check back later. Hoopla's digital content changes regularly.

# Step 3: Play!

Once you've found something you want to watch, read, or listen to, just press Borrow and then Play.

## **More information**

### How many titles can I borrow?

You can borrow six Hoopla titles per calendar month. Whether you borrow them all at once or spread them out is entirely up to you.

### *...and for how long?* Movies and TV are yours for three days, music for seven, and you get audiobooks for three weeks.

#### What about returning?

Titles will be automatically returned when the loan period is over. No overdue fees!
