

Get eReady with *OverDrive*[®] for Kindle Paperwhite



Follow these steps to borrow ebooks on your Kindle Paperwhite. You just need a library card!

Step 1: Maine InfoNet


From a computer, access the Maine InfoNet Download Library at download.maineinfonet.org.

Click **Sign In** in the top right corner, enter Portland Public Library in the space provided, and then enter your library card number.

Step 2: Finding titles

You can search for a title or author, or browse by genre and format. The Download Library home page showcases new, popular, and recently returned titles. You can learn more about a book (such as a synopsis or similar books) by clicking on the title.

When you find a title you'd like to borrow, click the green **Borrow** button. A window will pop up to notify you that the title has been added to your account. Go to your **Checkouts** to download. When you click **Download**, a menu will drop down for you to select a format. You will need to download in the **Kindle Books** format.

These icons will be gray on titles that are currently unavailable. You can place a hold to receive an email when they become available.

Step 3: Amazon

You will be redirected to Amazon's website. Select your Kindle device and click **Get library book**. You may be asked to log in to Amazon. When you see the **Thanks!** message, the book will wirelessly sync to your Kindle. *Note: Do not click Download at this point unless you are transferring via USB.*
